The Top 10 Degrees that Australia Offers

The top 10 degrees are a combination of skills which help the students who study in Australia gain employment.

1. Business and Management

Business schools in Australia are internationally renowned and have a pivotal focus on the Asia-Pacific region, providing and equipping students with a global perspective.

2. Accountancy/Accounting

An accountancy degree is always in demand and opens up a huge range of options, both for specialisation with further study options and for overseas employment. Tax and management accountancy roles are both listed on the trade shortage list.

3. Biotechnology

This is a good course from a job placement point of view and also from the point of view of doing higher research.

4. Creative Arts and Design

Australian universities offer a wide variety of course options, including performing arts, visual arts and crafts, graphic and design studies, communications and media studies etc.

5. Engineering Courses

Degrees accredited in Australian universities are equivalent to degrees in countries such as the US, Japan, Ireland and the UK. Therefore, it is a good course to go for.

6. Computer Science/IT

Computer Science/IT is an all weather programme in great demand.

In Australia, degree courses in computer science typically include software design, algorithms and programming languages and a good degree offers immediate placements.

7. Actuarial Science

This is a new area of study. The specialised science assesses risks in financial, insurance and other sectors by using mathematical and statistical methods. With the rise in machine learning, this industry is becoming more popular as industries like banking, finance, insurance, and pension schemes need graduates.

8. Architecture

An all time favorite subject and demand for well educated architects is always there. Accounting for sun, rain, wind and designing homes and businesses that are energy efficient and have minimal impact on the landscape is incredibly important. Architecture, both commercial and residential, is a career option that's in demand in Australia too.

9. Psychology

What budget should I have in mind?

In Australia most of the universities charge semester wise tuition fee. One year fee (for 3 semesters) including accommodation and food would be around 50,000 AUD (1 AUD = INR 48).

Are there any scholarship available?

No Australian university provide full scholarship. But there are universities which offer up to 25 per cent scholarship based on your performance.

Can I work in Australia while studying?

Yes, it is possible. Universities allow the students to take up a part time job for few hours each day during session breaks.

Is there any test of English knowledge?

IELTS score of 6-7 will be required in Australia.

What is the eligibility marks scored in 12th?

65 per cent and above marks is ideally required. Physical training marks are not counted.
