Context and Justification:

Learning Agenda:

- i. To understand Public Health Policy and implementation of various national schemes in India and also the role of the Department-related Parliamentary Committee on Health and Family welfare;
- ii. To learn the functioning of National Health Services (NHS), the UK, the policy formulations; Implementation and its challenges;
- iii. To interact with various Health Policy makers and experts in London and Leeds to have practical exposure to health professionals.

A Customised Leadership Programme on Public Health Policy Administration in Parliamentary Democracy on Public Health Policy Administration in Parliamentary Democracy, to be organized in New Delhi and London is a training programme meant only for government health officials in leadership position in government run hospitals and in ministries/departments duly nominated by the competent authority. The course fee, travel charges and hotel charges are to be paid by the sponsoring/nominating organisations.

Accommodation

- **i. In New Delhi:** The outstation participants are requested to arrange accommodation in Delhi on their own. The fees quoted by PARI does not include accommodation and local conveyance during the training period in New Delhi.
- **ii. In London:** The PARI in collaboration with the UK counterpart will arrange standard and comfortable accommodation (3/4 Star hotel) for the participants for 6 nights. Breakfast will be provided by the Hotel on all days.

Medical Insurance

The Participants are advised to get their Overseas Medical Insurance for the entire period of their stay in the UK done before leaving the country. The sponsoring organization is responsible to reimburse the premium amount paid for it.

Travel Arrangement

Domestic & International: The Sponsoring/Nominating organisations/departments will bear the cost for the participants' domestic travel and local conveyance for attending training programme in New Delhi as well as for return air tickets for travelling to London as per the entitlement of the participant. The participants are requested to purchase Air ticket only after receiving the Visa.

Passport

Personal Passport (Blue) will be required for travelling to London. Please make sure that your passport is valid for the next 6 months from the date of visa.

Visa Application

Once the nomination along with fee is received by PARI, will send the relevant documents to be attached while applying for visa. PARI will apply visa on **PRIORITY** basis and will fix the appointment with nearest VFS centres. The participants will have to visit the VFS centres for the biometrics as per the schedule.

Cancellation/Refund Policy

Cancellation can be done 30 days before the start of the course @ 20% deduction. If the cancellation is done between 30 days and 15 days before the start of the course, then 50% of the fees will be refunded. If the cancellation is done within 15 days of the start of the course, no fee will be refunded.
