## Logistics

Leadership Programme For Mental Health Systems Development to be organized in New Delhi and Melbourne is a training programme meant for government administrators, administrative heads in the Central and State Government levels, Autonomous Institutes and PSUs. The course fee, travel charges and hotel charges are to be paid by the sponsoring/nominating ministries/departments.

### Accommodation

### Travel Arrangement

Domestic & International: The Sponsoring/Nominating organisations/departments will bear the cost for the participants' domestic travel and local conveyance for attending training programme in New Delhi as well as for return air tickets for travelling to Melbourne as per the entitlement of the participant.

### Passport and VISA Application

The Delegates will travel on their personal (blue) passport which must have 6 months validity from the date of travel. Once the nomination along with the fee is received by us, we will send you the relevant documents to be attached while applying for a visa. The application process will be completed by PARI. The visa charges are included in the Training Fee.

### Cancellation/Refund Policy
